

How to Read Your Student Schedule

Your student number, which is on your student schedule, remains the same throughout your school years in the Omaha Public Schools. You will need to memorize it since you have to enter it when you go through the lunch line. If you have not yet memorized your student number, it would be a good idea to take your schedule card with you to the cafeteria the first few times you eat lunch.

“Term” refers to how often this class meets. Two terms equal a semester. Four terms equal a year. If you have the same class scheduled for two terms, you are enrolled in a semester class. If you have a class for four terms, you are enrolled in a year-long course. Sometimes terms are called quarters.

“TAKE FLIGHT” or Advisement is special class that meets every day. During the first few school days the class will be extended for orientation. After the first week, advisement or Take FLIGHT will meet daily at the beginning of the day.

“Aday”-“Bday” Block Schedule Sample

*Elective courses change by term or semester depending on the course. PE/Music are considered electives too. PE and performing music classes meet all year for half a block.

A "Room" that begins with a 1 such as 150 or 165 is located on the first floor.
Rooms that begin with a 2 such as 250 or 265 are located on the second floor.
Rooms that begin with a 0 such and 040 or 065 are in the lowest level of the school.
